

## **Random Acts of Kindness - Classwide** ***Making Friends – Manners***

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### **What are we doing?**

The students will be recognized on a star chart for engaging in random acts of kindness

### **What do we need?**

Start charts for each student

Second Step Curriculum or similar – kindness curriculum that teaches things like compliments, encouragement, including others, sharing, offering help, etc.

Pre-made photos of kindness behaviors to post around the classroom

### **How do we do it?**

Kindness behavior of the week - Each week discuss a particular kindness behavior, post it in the room after the class discussion, keep posted for visual reminder

Teachers, para educators, peers, other adults can put stars on the star charts for each student when students are observed engaging in the kindness behaviors. Each week more and more kindness behaviors will be added. The students will watch their own star charts grow.

### **When are we done?**

Continue as necessary. Once everyone in the classroom reaches a certain number of stars on their charts (this will promote peers to help each other get stars), have a class kindness party

### **How do we collect data?**

Follow data collection protocol, cumulative data
